- Give the Judge/Commissioner a copy of your papers (if required by your county's Local Court Rules); AND
- Have a copy of your papers served on all other parties or their lawyers; AND
- Go to the hearing.

The court may not allow you to testify at the motion hearing. Read your county's Local Court Rules, if any. Bring proposed orders to the hearing.

**To the person requesting this order:**

You must have this order, and the paperwork you filed with the court to get this order, personally served on the other party by someone 18 or older who is not a party to this case.

**To the person receiving this order:**

If you do not agree with the requests in the motion, file a statement (using form *FL All Family 135, Declaration*) explaining why the court should not approve those requests. You may file other written proof supporting your side.

**TO APPLY FOR LEGAL REPRESENTATION BY DEPARTMENT OF  
ASSIGNED COUNSEL**

1. You must go **IN PERSON** to Clerk's Office at 930 Tacoma Avenue South, Room 108, Tacoma, Washington, within **three** (3) business days of arraignment on a criminal matter or **five** (5) business days of after service of documents in a civil matter.
  - a. The hours to apply are **Monday through Friday, 10:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M.**
  - b. You can call (253)798-3781 to schedule an appointment.
  
2. You **MUST** have the following paperwork with you, in order to apply:
  - a. Any paperwork you receive from the Court, which should have your case number and the next court date.
  - b. Verification of your income (**last 30 days**), unemployment compensation, or retirement/disabled pay.
  - c. Proof of all public assistance that you receive (**current**) - **Award Letter**, Check Stub, (Note: Food Stamp Card is **not** proof).
  - d. **Proof of your basic living expenses (receipts or copies of)** - for example: Rent or Mortgage Payments (Equity Denial Letter from bank if buying a house), Utilities, Phone, Car Payments, Car Insurance, Child Support, Day Care, etc., handwritten support statement if living with someone and not contributing to the basic household expenses.
  - e. Proof of any other unusual expenses paid in the past 30 days (medical/dental payments, collection debts, institutional loans, etc.).
  - f. Self Employed - Bring in your tax statements, business ledger, reported sales tax, bank statements (last 60 days), and your business license.
  
3. In regard to a criminal matter: You **MUST** reapply for representation each time that you are charged with a NEW OFFENSE and/or each time you QUASH A WARRANT and reset the court date for the same offense.
  
4. In regard to a civil matter: Failure to go to Pretrial Services may result in a determination that you have waived your right to a public defender representation in this action.

If you qualify for assigned counsel, an attorney will be appointed to represent you for your **CURRENT** case in that Court **ONLY**.

**YOU MUST APPEAR IN COURT ON THE NEXT SCHEDULED COURT DATE WHETHER OR NOT YOU HAVE HAD CONTACT WITH YOUR ASSIGNED ATTORNEY. YOUR FAILURE TO APPEAR MAY RESULT IN A BENCH WARRANT BEING ISSUED FOR YOUR ARREST.**
